



In pursuance of an Order Nº 1475 and dated the 3^d of April 1769 Survey'd for Caleb Graden the above described tract of Land Containing three Hundred and fifteen acres, & 56 perches with an allowance proportioned to 6th Cent for Roads, Situate on the old path leading from Kiskiminnates to Shirlees old Town, on the East side of the Allegany River, Survey'd the 3^d of May 1770.
