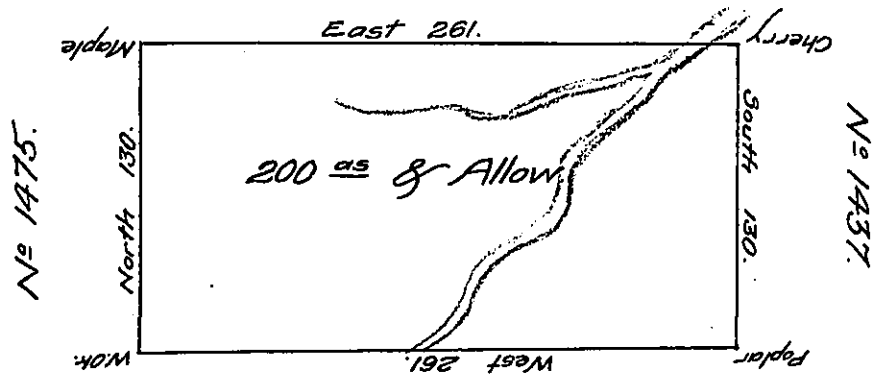

In pursuance of an act of Genl Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General with the aproba-tion of the Hon the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 - the above described tract of two Hundred acres & allow. of 6<sup>sq</sup>. Cent for roads &c. No MCCCCLXXII situate in Dist No 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland:
