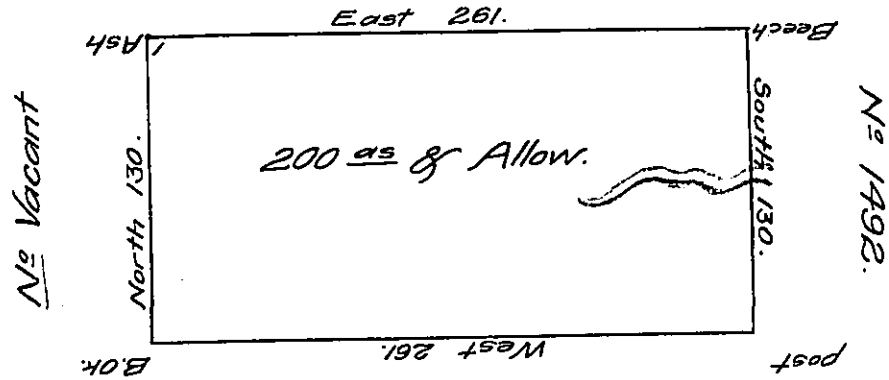

In pursuance of an act of Genl Assembly of the state of Pennsya<sup>a</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Genl with the approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 p<sup>er</sup> Cent. for Roads &c. No MCCCCXCIII situate in Dist. No 7 on the West side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
