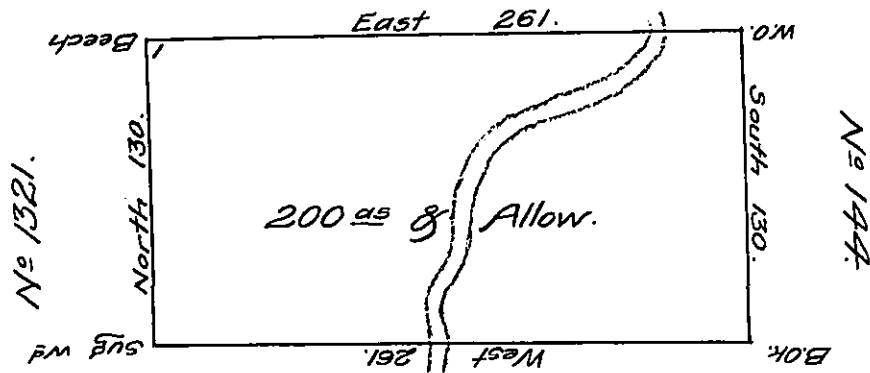

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the state of Pennsy<sup>a</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febuary 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>le</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 the above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 ~~per~~ Cent for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCCXXIV situate in Dist N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in Westmorland County
