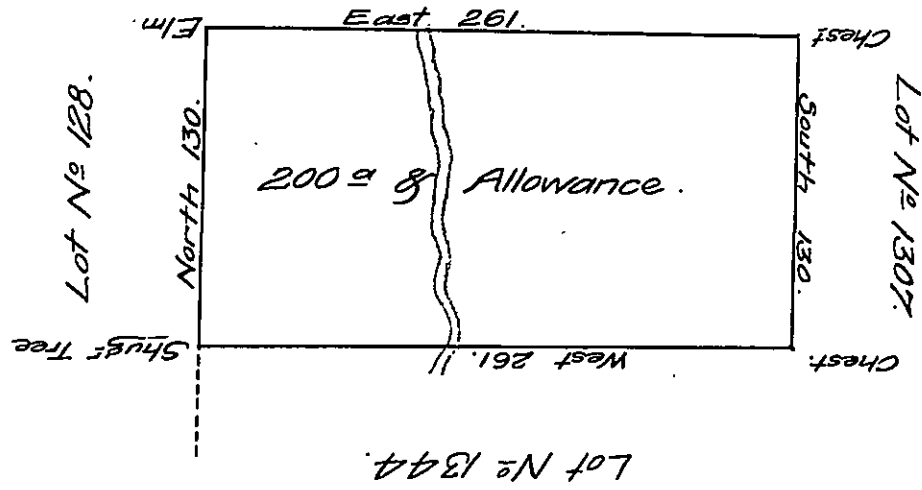


Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1346.



In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>o</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on 15<sup>th</sup> July 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow<sup>e</sup> &c. of 6 ~~pp~~ Cent for roads &c- N<sup>o</sup> MCCCXLV situate on the West side of the Alegheny river in the County of Westmorland
