



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Second day of Septem^r 1734 Surveyed unto Christopher Smith a tract of Land Situate in New Cowissiope in the County of Philad^a Beginning at a post thence by Vacant Land North West one hundred and seventy perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South West two hundred perches to a Large White Oak thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and seventy perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East two hundred perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing two hundred acres with the usual Allowance of Six ~~of~~ Cent.
