



By Virtue of a warrant Dated the Sixth day of April 1744  
 Granted to John Ross, and originally Surveyed by Edward Scull then  
 Deputy Surveyor of that District and shortly after the date of the war-  
 rant there was Surveyed for the said John Ross the above discribed Tract  
 of Land then in Philadelphia County now in Berks in District Township  
 Berks County and Resurveyed the same for John Lesh on the 25 of  
 March 1786 Containing one Hundred and Eight Acres and 152 perches  
 and the allowance of Six ~~per~~ Cent.
