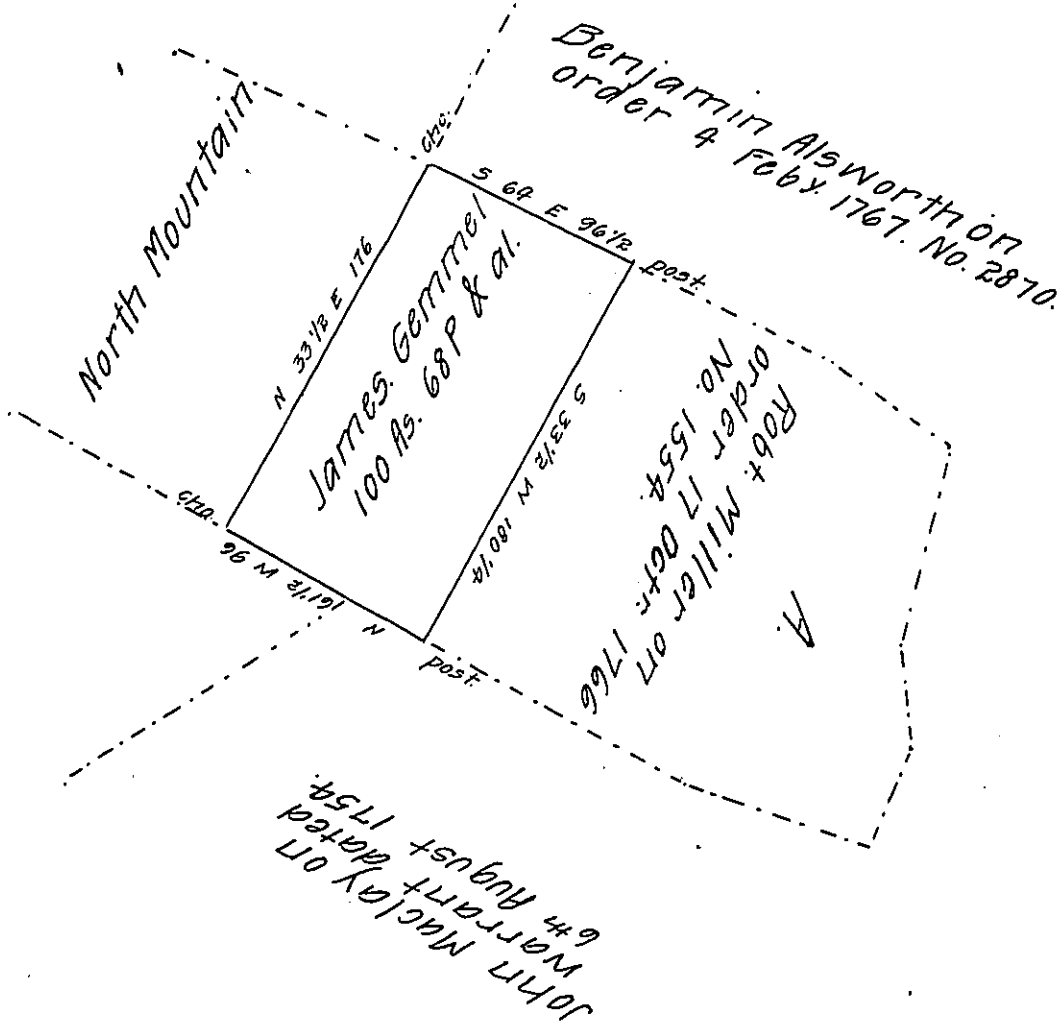


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Lurgan township Franklin County containing one hundred acres & sixty eight perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed 23^d September 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several acts of assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an order of Survey dated 16 October 1766 No. 1547. Granted to James Gemmel for 100 acres in Lurgan township "bounded by Benjamin Alsworth on the north Robert Miller on the east and John Macclay on the south.

Report. The above survey is laid where the location evidently intended but the land is included in a survey of 301^a 105 P made for Robert

Miller the 9th May 1768 on his order dated 17 October 1766 No. 1554. the dotted figure A represents the balance of survey on Millers order James & Robert Strain & John Winger owners & occupiers W. S. Davis.
