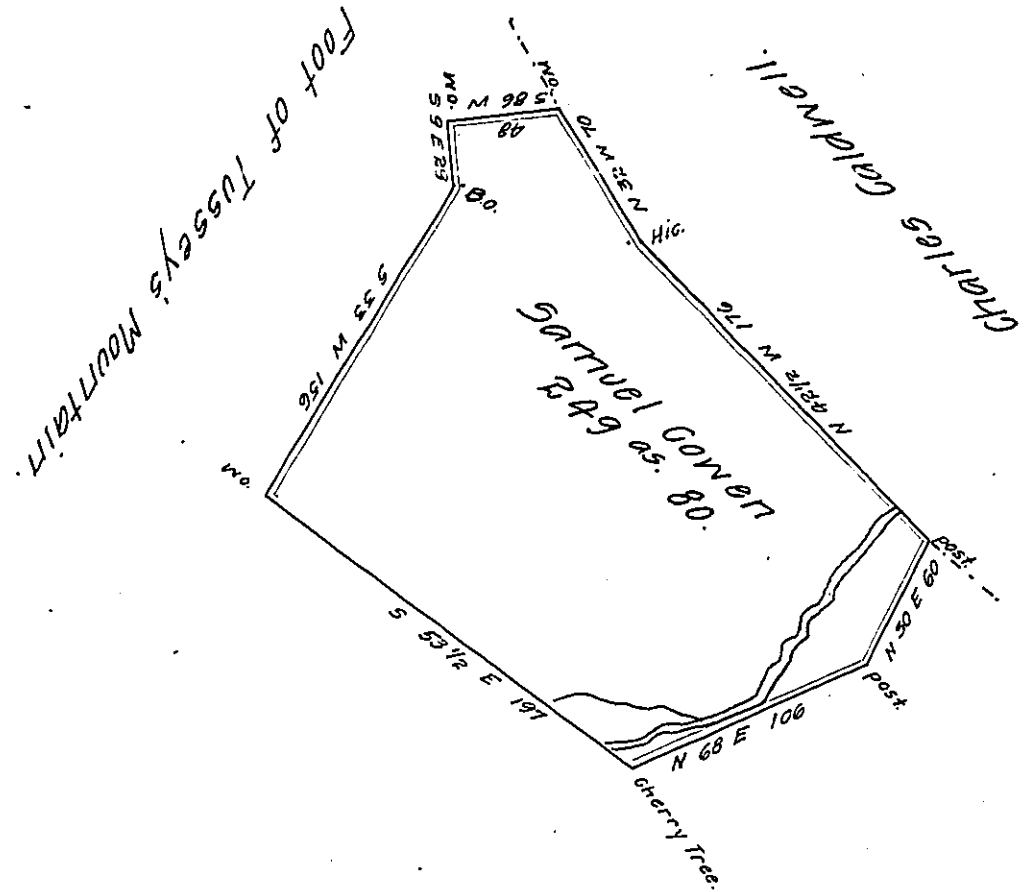


FORM NO 1.



Situate on a run emptying into the Frankstown Branch of Juniatta river. In Porter township Huntingdon County containing two hundred and forty nine acres and eighty perches and allowance of six per cent. Surveyed for Sarruel Cowen on order No. 1880. dated the 10th day November 1766.

The red lines represent a survey made for David Caldwell on warrant dated the 12th day of July 1788 This tract interferes two hundred and forty nine acres and eighty perches with the Sarruel Cowen tract. Sarruel Cowen conveyed to William Johnston who devised the same to his heirs, who conveyed to David Caldwell who obtained the aforesaid warrant David Caldwell devised the same to his widow & heirs who now own the same.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of July 1908.
