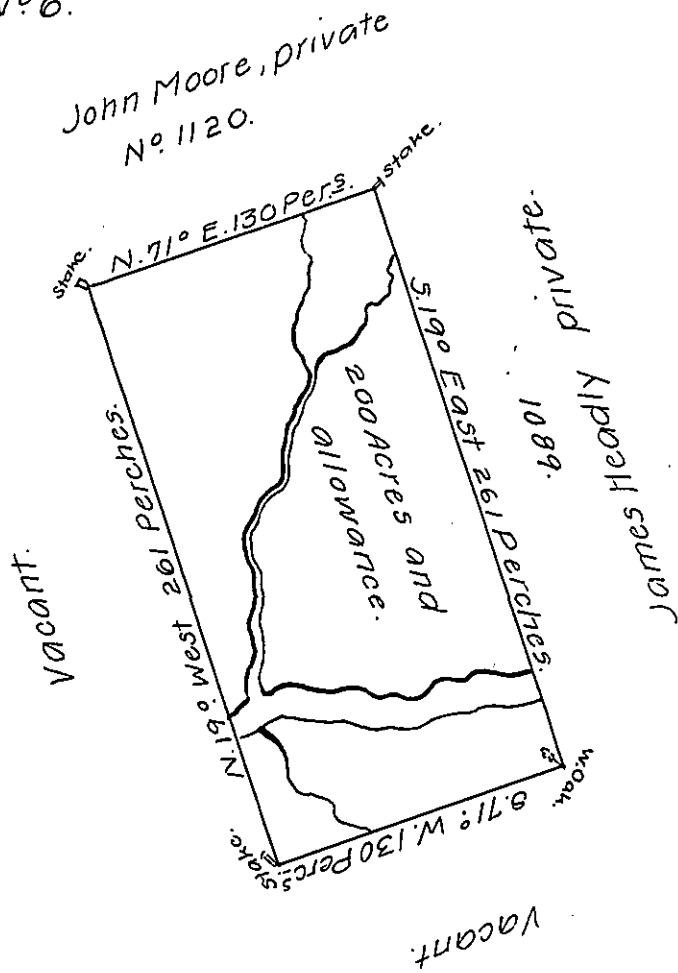


Donation land in District N^o 6.

Patent issued to George Dannacker in right of Augustus Millesock private dated 7th of May 1795 in lieu of a tract found to lie in the State of New York.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th Day of February 1785 "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth;" and by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council. I have Surveyed on the 5th Day of Novemb^r. 1785 the above discribed Tract of Two Hundred Acres of Land & allowance of six P^{ct} for roads &c. N^o 1099 situate in D^{istrict} N^o 6 on the west side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
