


Donation land in District N<sup>o</sup>. 6.

Patent issued to George Dannacker in right of Augustus Millesock private dated 7<sup>th</sup> of May 1795 in lieu of a tract found to lie in the state of New York.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1785 "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth;" and by order of the Surveyor General with the Approval of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council. I have Surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1785 the above described Tract of Two Hundred Acres of Land & allowance of six  $\frac{1}{8}$  ct for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup>. 1099 situate in District N<sup>o</sup>. 6 on the West side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
