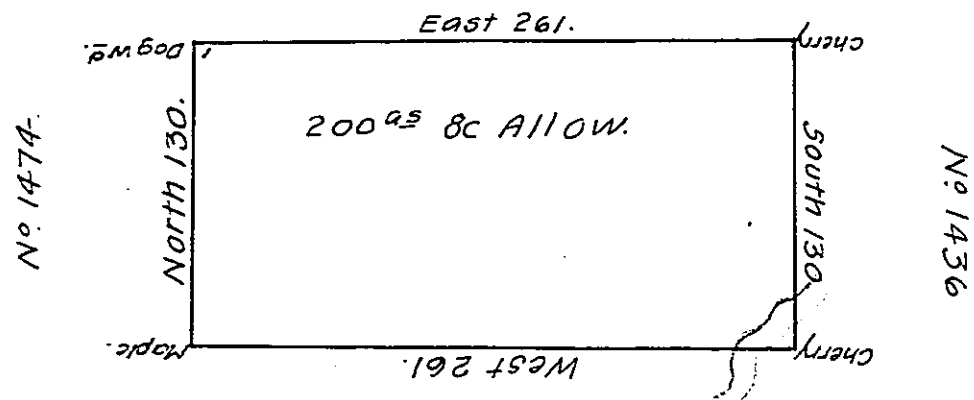

In pursuance of an act of Genl Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febuary 1785 Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hund<sup>d</sup> Acres & Allow. of 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Cent. for roads & N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCLXXIII situate in Dist<sup>t</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Allegh<sup>n</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
