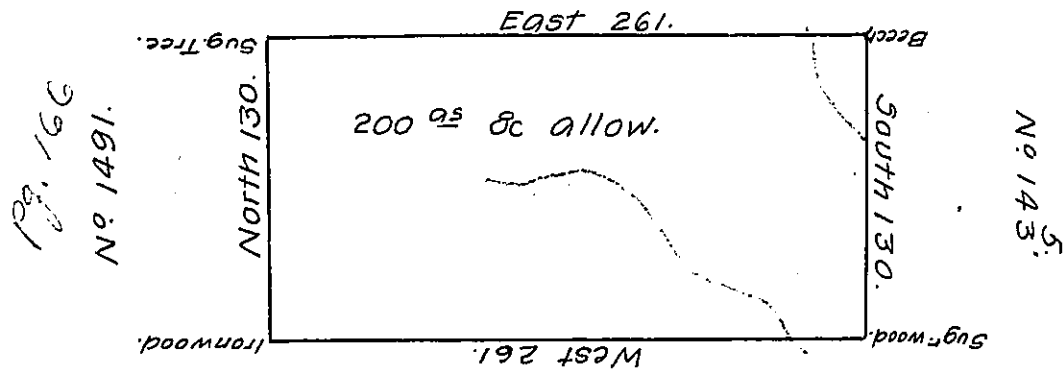

In Pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled An act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation <sup>Lands</sup> promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Approbation of the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred acres & Allowance of 6 <sup>th</sup> Cent. for Roads &c. No MCCCCLVI situate in Dist No 7 on the west side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmorland.
