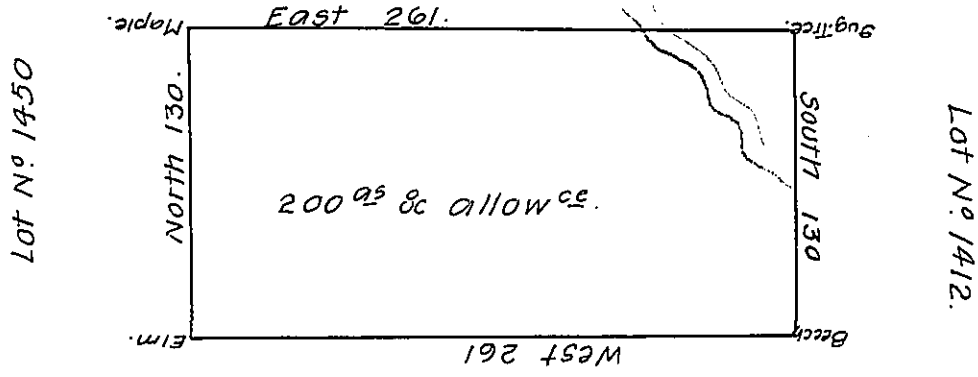

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>le</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of 6<sup>th</sup> cent for roads &c N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCXXI situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup>. river In the County of Westmorland.
