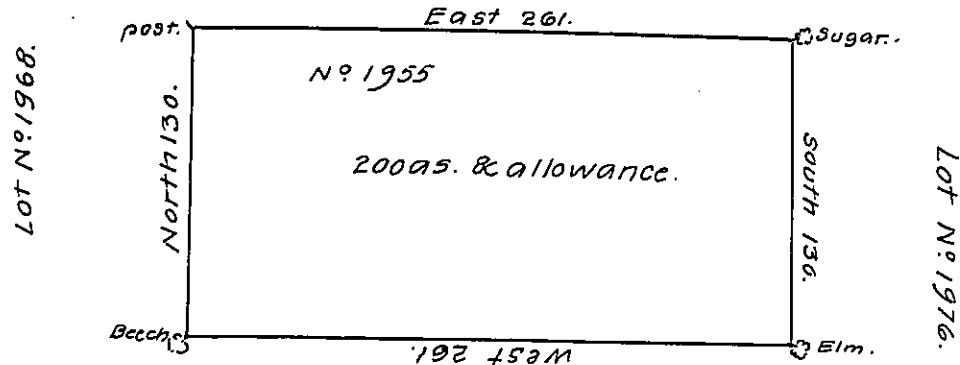


Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1956

In pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 1785 entitled "An act for directing the mode for distributing the donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed this 16 of July 1785 the above described Tract of two hundred acres & allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  C<sup>t</sup>. for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MDCCCLV, situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 10 on the west side of Alleghany River in the county of Westmoreland.
