

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24-day of February 1785 entitled "An act for directing the mode of destributing the Donation lands promised to the troops of this commonwealth," And by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon be Executive Council I have surveyed on the 10th day of August-the above described tract of three hundred acres and allowance of six &Ct for roads & No XCIII Situate in district No 10 on the west side of Alleghany river in the county of Westmoreland.
