In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, February passed the 24 day of Angust, 1785 entitled "An act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth", And by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 9th day of August 1785, the above described tract of five hundred Acres and allowance of Six & Ct. for roads & N° CXCII situate in district N°10 on the west side of Alleghany river in the county of Westmoreland.
