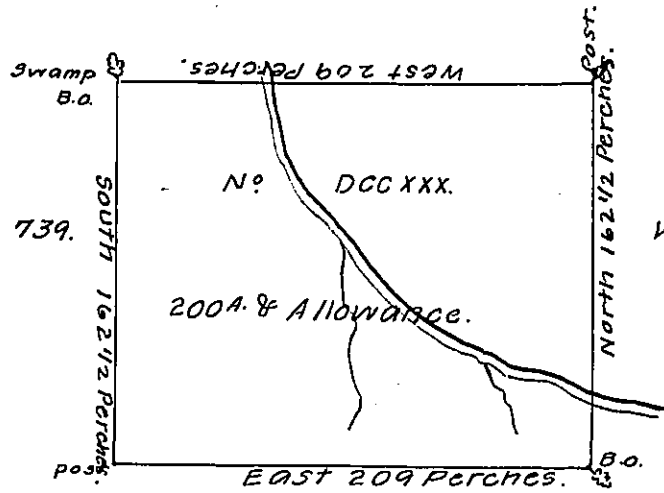

 the 24th day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the Mode
 of distributing the Donation Lands Promised the Troops of this Common-
