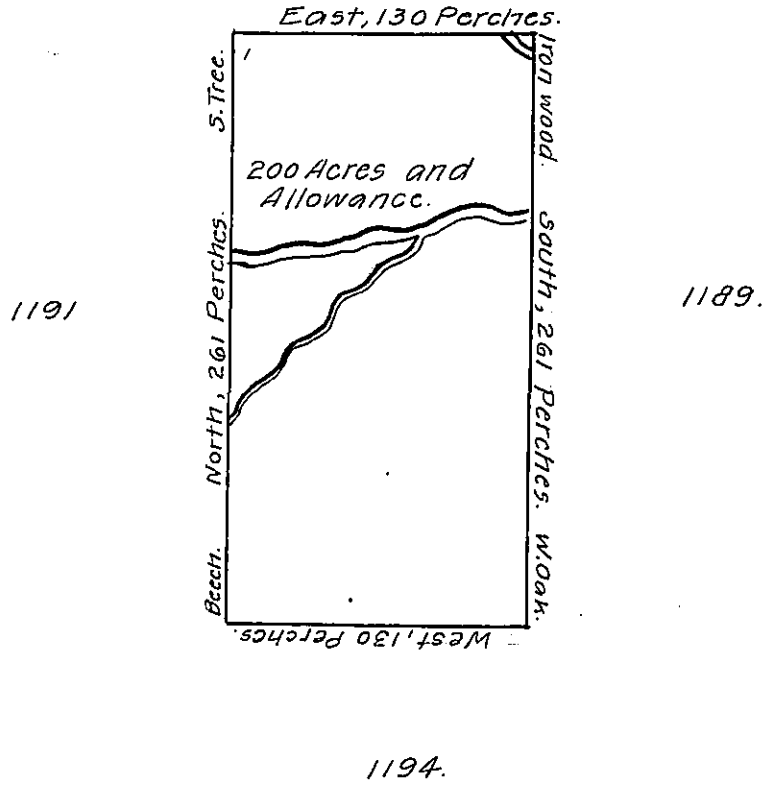


Donation-Land, in District No. 6.

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intituled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the Eighteenth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Land, and Allowance of six per Cent for Roads, &c No. 1190 situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
