In pursuance of the Application N<sup>o</sup> 3792 for 100<sup>9</sup>. Dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1767 as appears by a Draught signed by said W<sup>m</sup> Matthews. Thomas Armor Obtained a Patent for the part N<sup>o</sup> 2. It appears by blocking the Trees that the Line X was run but 25 years ago. To prevent a Lawsuit the present Owners Viz. Andrew Klinedinst & Andrew Low have accommodated the matter and at the Request of Andrew Klinedinst I have Resurveyed the remaining part 17<sup>9</sup> & 155<sup>9</sup> & all. that he may be enabled to obtain a Patent this 9<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1797.
