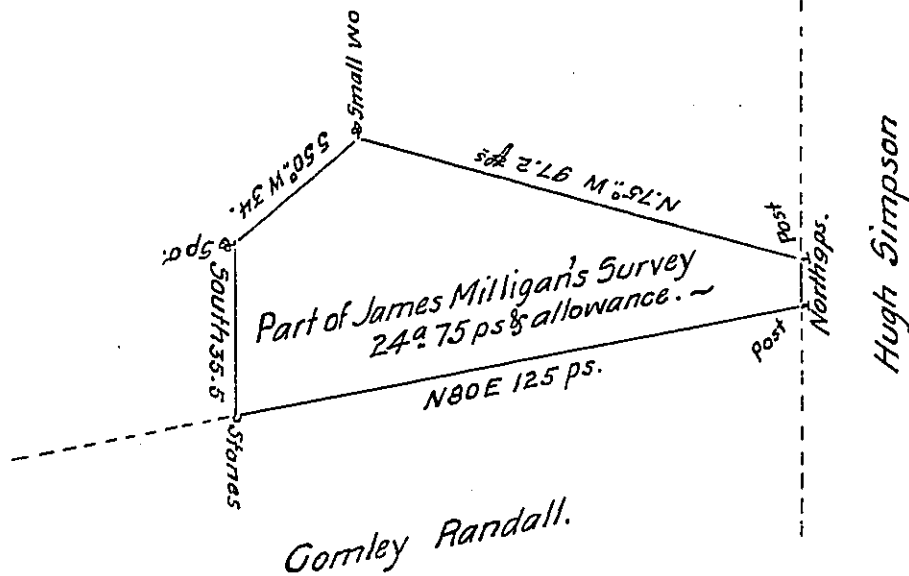


Residue of James Milligan's 328^a Survey, of which this is part
