 ing certain Reserved Tracts therein named, the Instructions of the
 Late Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799, and the Order of the
 Surveyor General dated the 18th day of May 1799, Surveyed the 26th
 day of October 1799, the above described tract of land being No. 21
 of the Reserved Tract called Erie (now) Erie County, Containing
 eighty four acres and one hundred thirty two perches, strict meas-
