



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April 1799, for selling certain Reserved Tracts of Land therein named, the Instructions of the Late Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799 and the Instructions of the Surveyor General, dated the 18th day of May 1799, Surveyed the 27th day of October 1799, the above described tract of land being No. 26 of the Reserved Tract called Erie (now) Erie County, containing one hundred and twenty four acres and fifty perches, strict Measure.
