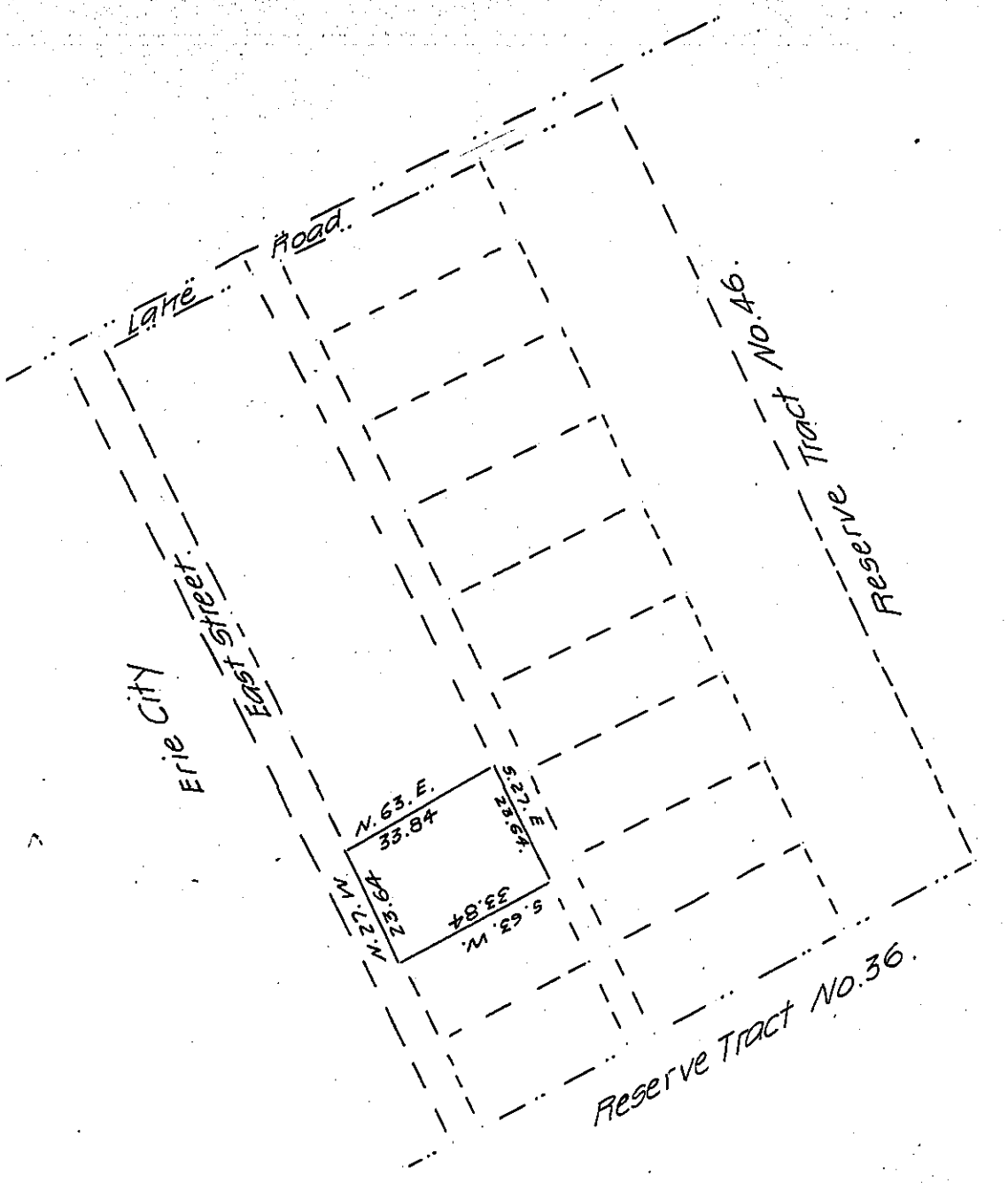


FORM NO 1.

Description. Commencing at the south line of an alley on the east
 line of East street at a point thirty feet northwardly of the point of
 intersection of said east line by the south line of Tenth street extend-
 ed across east street thence 63° East $33\frac{84}{100}$ rods along the south line of
 said alley, thence south 27° east $23\frac{64}{100}$ rods thence south 63° West $33\frac{84}{100}$
 rods to the east line of East street thence north 27° West $23\frac{64}{100}$ rods to the
 place of beginning Containing five acres of land, being subdivision No.
 of Brewster's Subdivision of Reserve Tract No. 37 adjoining the Town of Erie.

 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
