Description of land to be patented Beginning at a point in the north line of Charles Brandes land, at a point of intersection with a sixty foot street, thence north 27° W. 18<sup>33</sup> perches thence north 63° east 43.86 perches, thence south 27° E. 18<sup>33</sup> perches to a post in the north line of said Charles Brandes land and thence along said Brandes north line south 63° East 43.86 perches to the Place of Beginning being subdivision No. 8 of Brewster's subdivision of Reserve tract No. 37.
