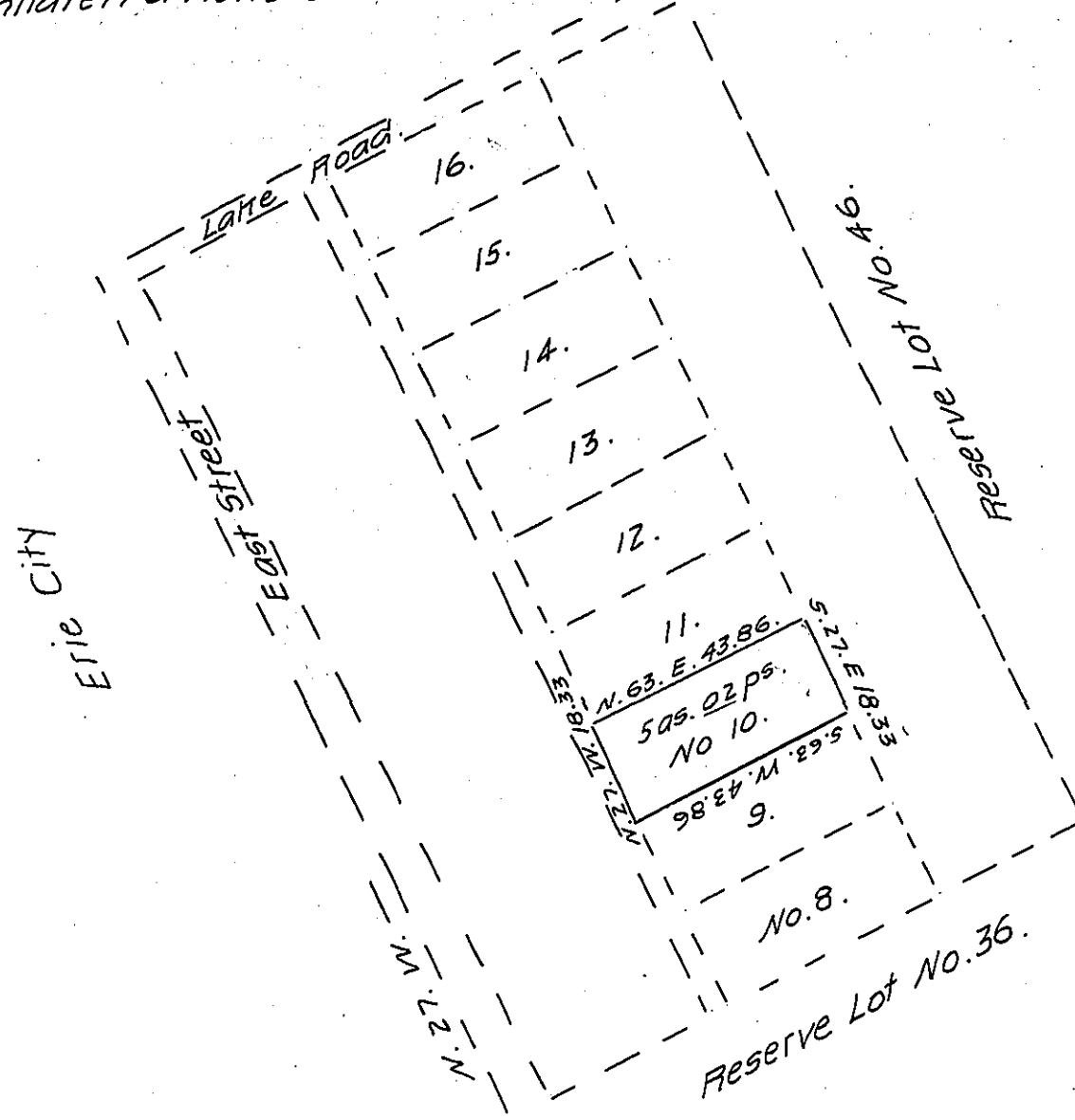

Description of land Beginning at the north west corner of Lot No. 10 in Brewster's Subdivision of Reserve Tract No. 37, thence north 63° East 43.86 perches to a post in the West line of John Hess land, thence south 27° East along said Hess land 18.33 perches to a post, thence south 63° west 43.86 perches to a post, thence north 27° west 18.33 perches to the place of Beginning being subdivision No. 10 in Brewster's subdivision of Reserve Tract No. 37 adjoining the City of Erie.
