



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April, 1799,
 for the selling certain reserved Tracts of Land therein named,
 the Instructions of the late Governor dated the 14th day of May
 1799, and the order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated
 the 18th day of May 1799, surveyed the 4th day of November,
 the above described Tract of Land being Lot No. 6 of the Reserved
 Tract called Franklin in (now) Venango County containing
 fifty eight acres and seventy one perches, Strict Measure
