



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April, 1799 for the selling certain reserved Tracts of land therein named, the instructions of the late Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799 and the order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated the 18th day of May 1799. Surveyed the 1st day of November 1799, the above described Tract of Land being Lot No. 2 of the Reserved Tract, called Franklin, in (now) Venango County, Containing ninety four acres and forty one perches, Strict Measure
