



By virtue of a warrant issued by the Secretary of the land office of Penna dated the eighth day of April 1834 on which is surveyed unto Daniel Hornbecht on the 1st June 1835, an Island, in the River Delaware, called "Squirrel Island" opposite the land of John Bertstraser, Richard Brodhead and John F. Linderman and the above said Daniel Hornbechts other land in the Township of Lehman and County of Pike, containing twenty eight acres and thirty one perches and allowance of six per cent.
