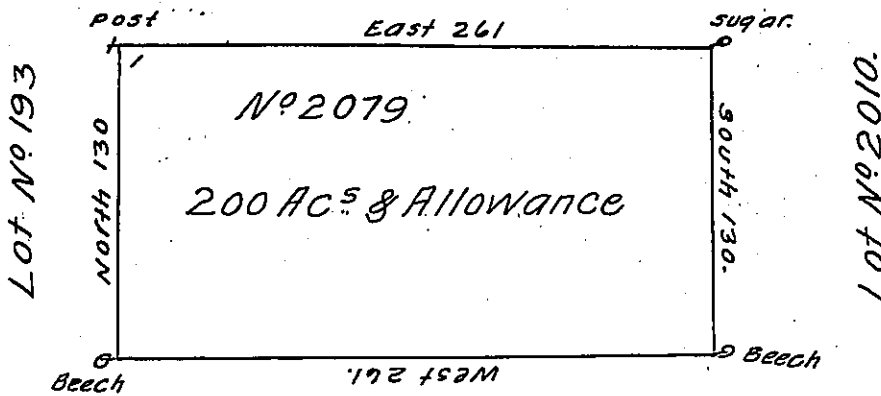

In pursuance of An Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24 day of February 1785. entitled "An act for directing the Mode of distributing the donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth". And by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{ble} Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 5th day of August 1785 the Above described tract of two hundred Acres And Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Ct. for Roads &c. N^o MMLXXIX. situate in district N^o 10 on the West Side of Alleghany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
