



Situate in White Deer township Union County surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1834 by virtue of an order Granted to Jonathan Hoge Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769, No 2324 containing three Hundred acres with the usual allowance &c and is Designated by the Yellow lines

Note The same tract of land interferes & is included in a survey made the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1794 for John Titsworth in pursuance of his warrant Dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1794 & is now accepted by James Robb without title - and is Designated by the green lines.
