A Draft of a tract of land called — situate on the waters — Mahantango in Mahanoy Township joining land surveyed for James Burd & others including an Improvement in Northum<sup>d</sup> County containing in the Black Lines one Hundred & Eighty-one acres & allowance & Eight acres  $\frac{3}{4}$  & allowance in the red lines which last is returned to John Bickle by virtue of a warrant Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785 but claimed by Peter Troutman by virtue of his improvement made ten years ago (he says) surveyed the above for Peter Troutman the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1791 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1790. Note the pice in dispute was cleared out <sup>of old</sup> an Line claimed by Troutman & surveyed by — Sm<sup>ll</sup> for George Myer
