



Situate in Longswamp Township, Berks County, Surveyed on a Warrant dated the twelfth day of November 1751 granted to Frederick Helwig (said to have been originally surveyed on Warr^t to Jacob Hans dated October 10th 1738) containing One hundred and Seventeen acres, one hundred and fifty perches, and allowance of 6 # Ct. for roads &c.
