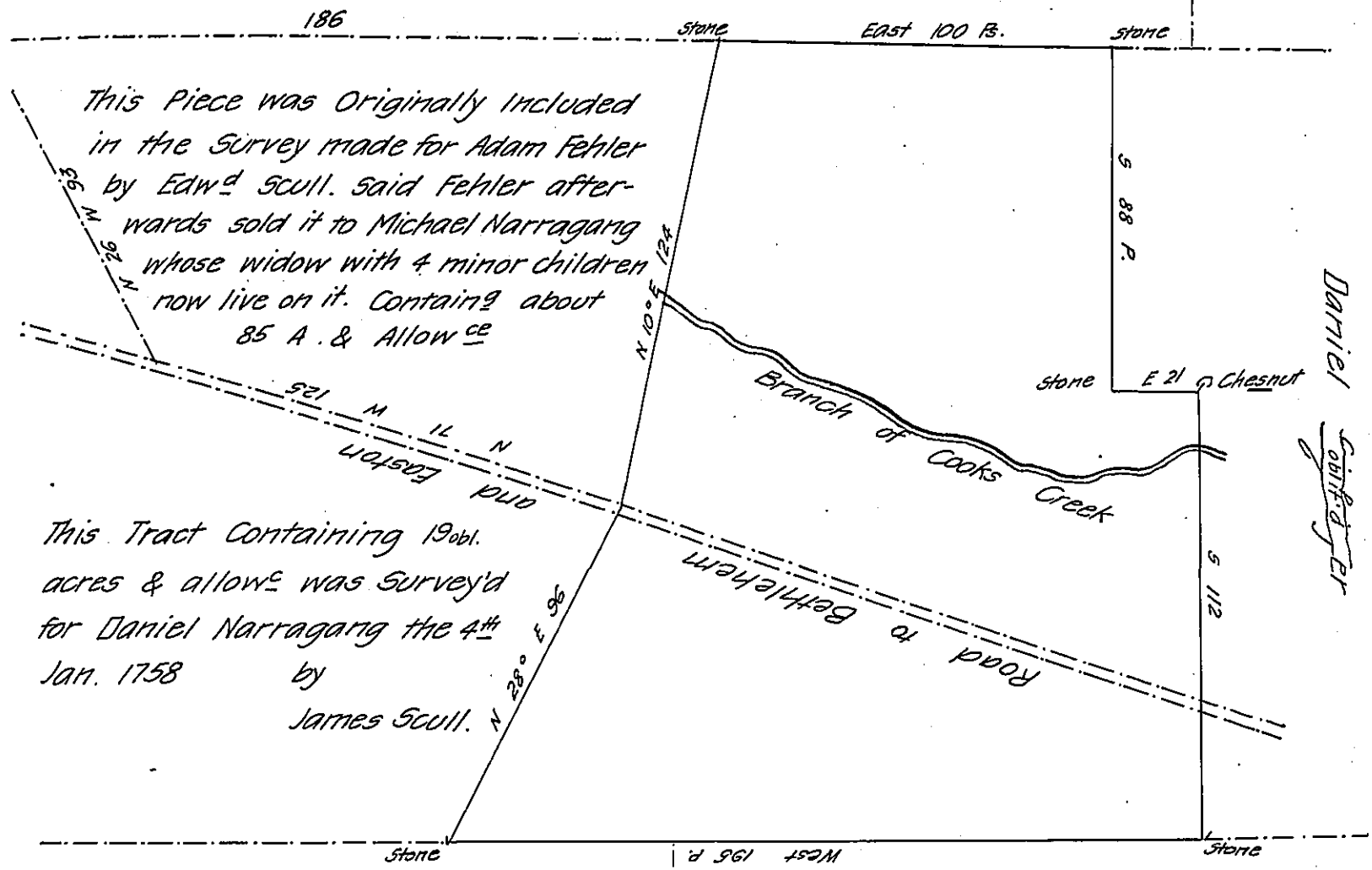

Draught of a tract of Land in the Township of Lower Saucon in the
County of Northampton Containing 150 acres & the usual allow^{ce} of 6 p^{ct} Cent.
formerly Surveyed by Edward Scull for Adam Fehler who Improved the same &
lived & dyed thereon which is now in the possession of his Widow Dorothy Fehler
with several minor Children who it is hoped will merit the regard of the Sur-
veyor Gen^l & the other Proprietary Officers, preferable to any ungenerous Intruder,
for such men there are in the County, of which we have had recent proof in the
present case. - Resurveyed the 17th Aug 1778 at the request of the 6^d Widow &
Michael Getter the other Exec^r of the said deceased P^r
