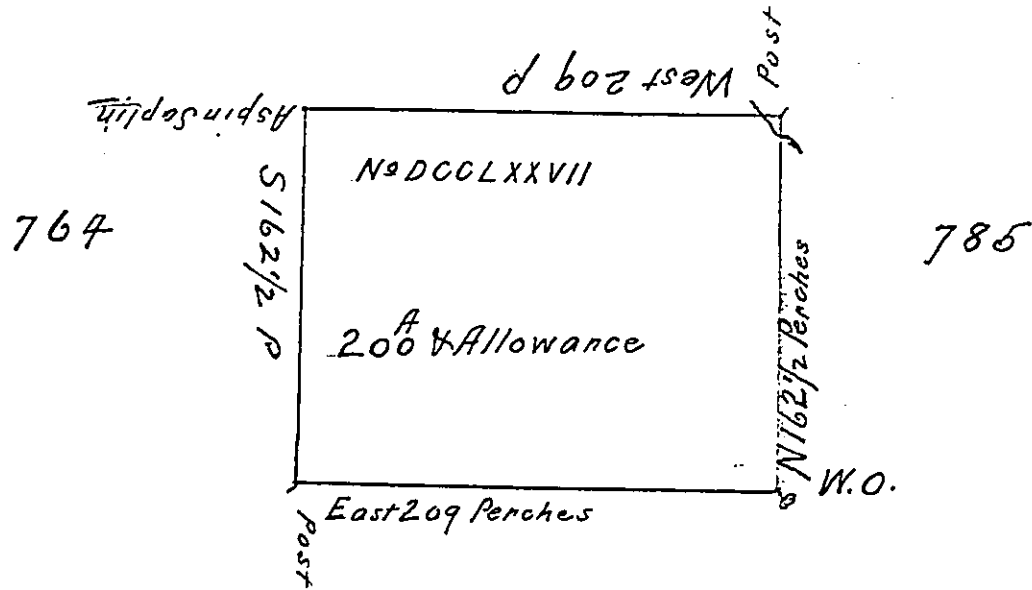

Situate in District N° 4 on the West Side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland
