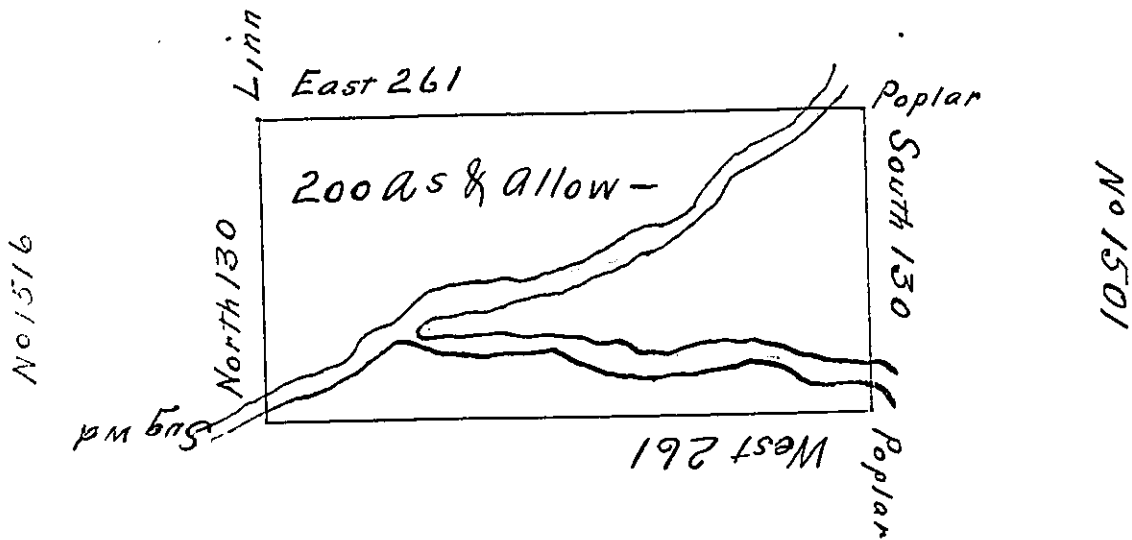

Intituled an Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands — promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Septem<sup>r</sup>. 1785. the above Described tract of Two Hundred Acres & Allow: of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for roads &c No ~~M~~ MCCIII. Situate in Dist No. 7. on the West Side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River, in the County of Westmorland.
