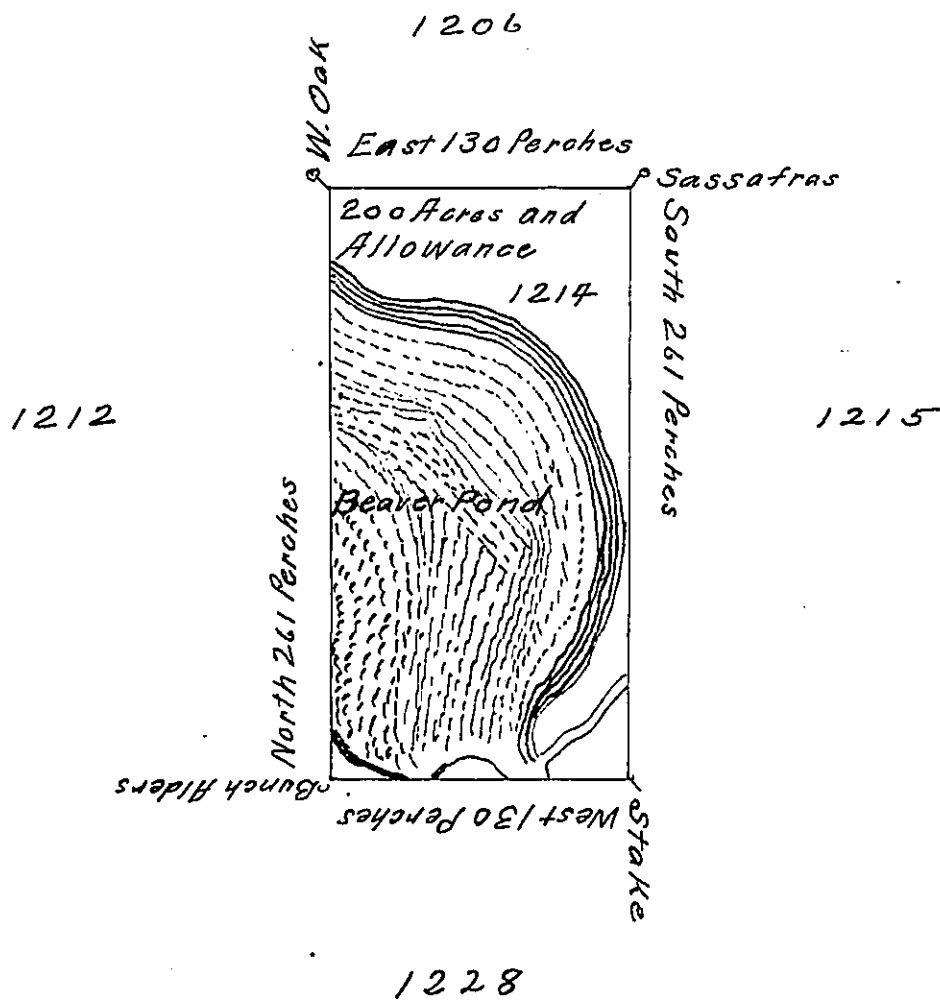


DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No 6,

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the
State of Pennsylvania, passed the Twentyfourth Day of February
1785, intitled, An Act for directing the Mode of distributing
the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Common-
wealth, and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the
Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council,
I have Surveyed, on the Twentieth Day of November, 1785, the above
described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance
of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. No 1214. Situate in District No 6.
on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
