

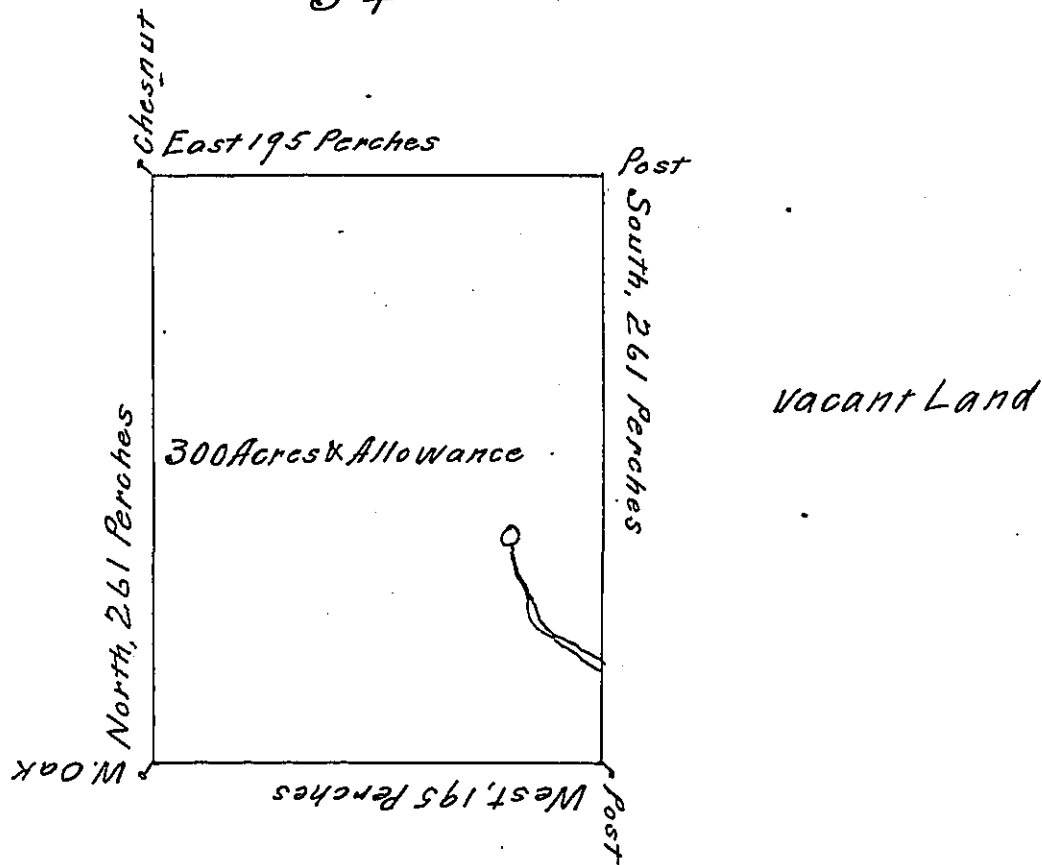

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth; and by Order of the Surveyor General, With the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have Surveyed, on the Seventeenth Day of November, 1785, the above described Tract of Three hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c, No 53, Situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
