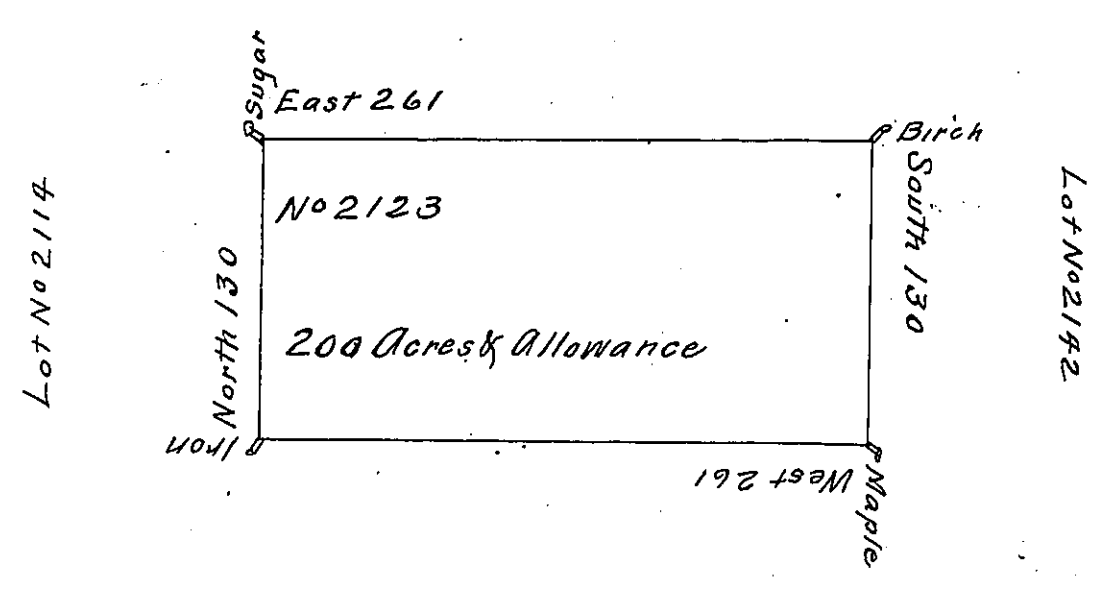


Lot No 2122

 entitled "An act for directing the Mode of distributing the donation
 lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth" And by order of the
 Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble Executive Council,
 I have Surveyed on the 22nd day of August 1785, the above descri-
 bed tract of Two hundred acres and allowance of Six p.c.t for roads
 &c No M MCXXIII, Situate in district No 10, on the West Side of
 Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland.
