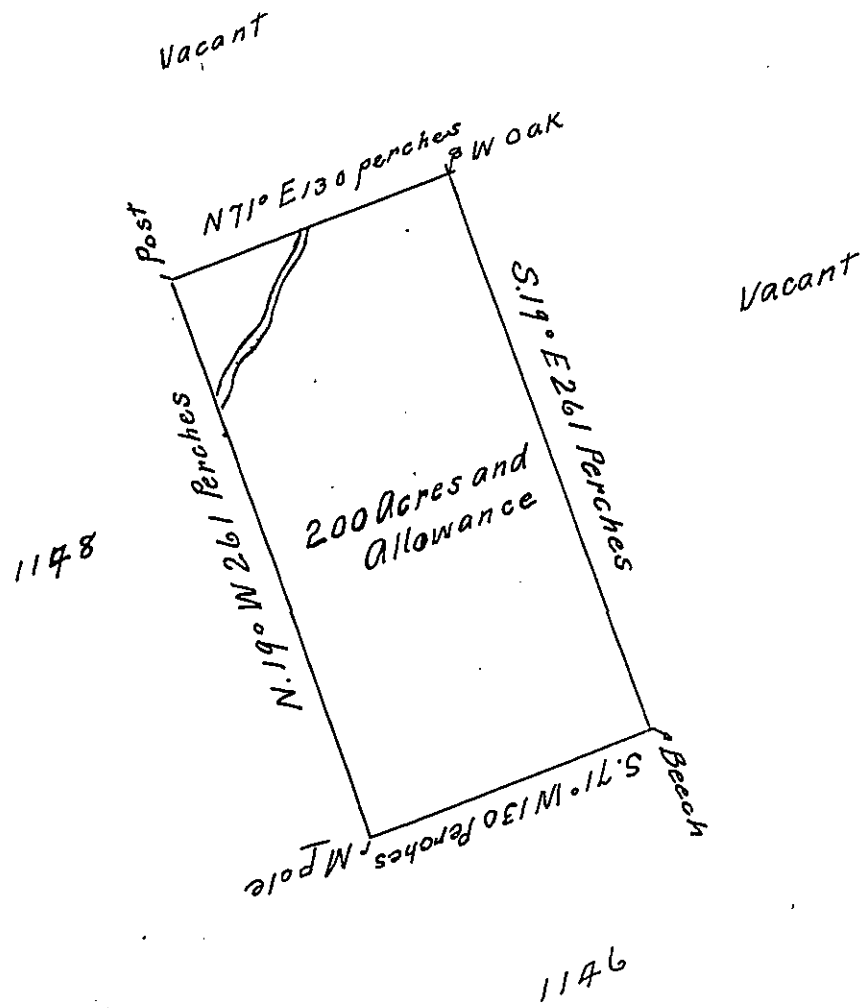


Donation-Land in District No 6

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands — promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have Surveyed, on the Fourth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent For Roads, &c. No 1147. — Situate in District No. 6. On the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland
