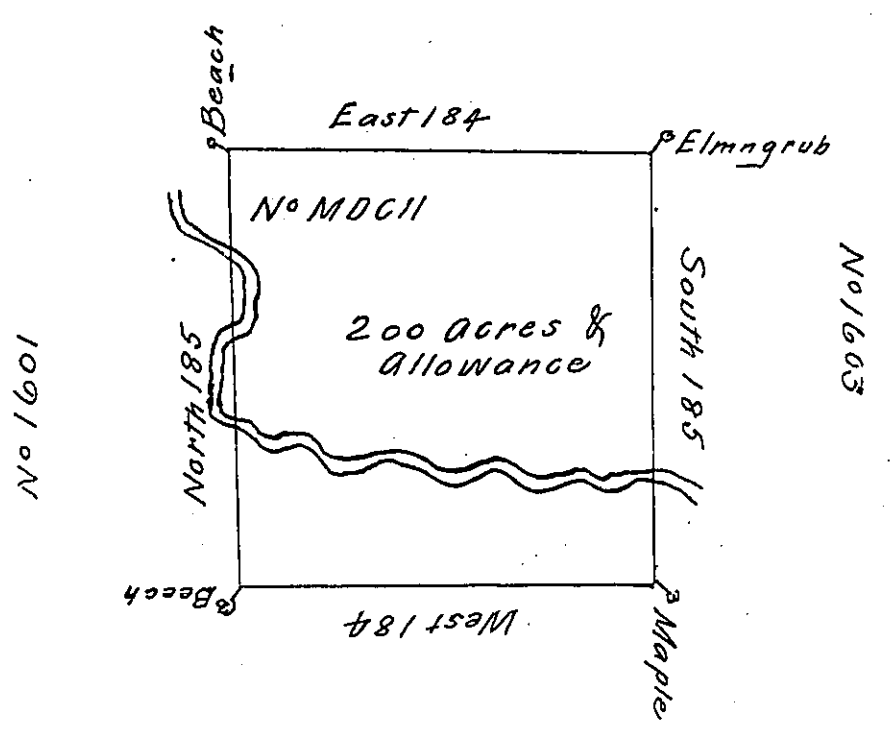

*In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785. the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of Six per Cent, for roads, &c. No. 1602 Situate in District No. 8. on the West Side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.*
