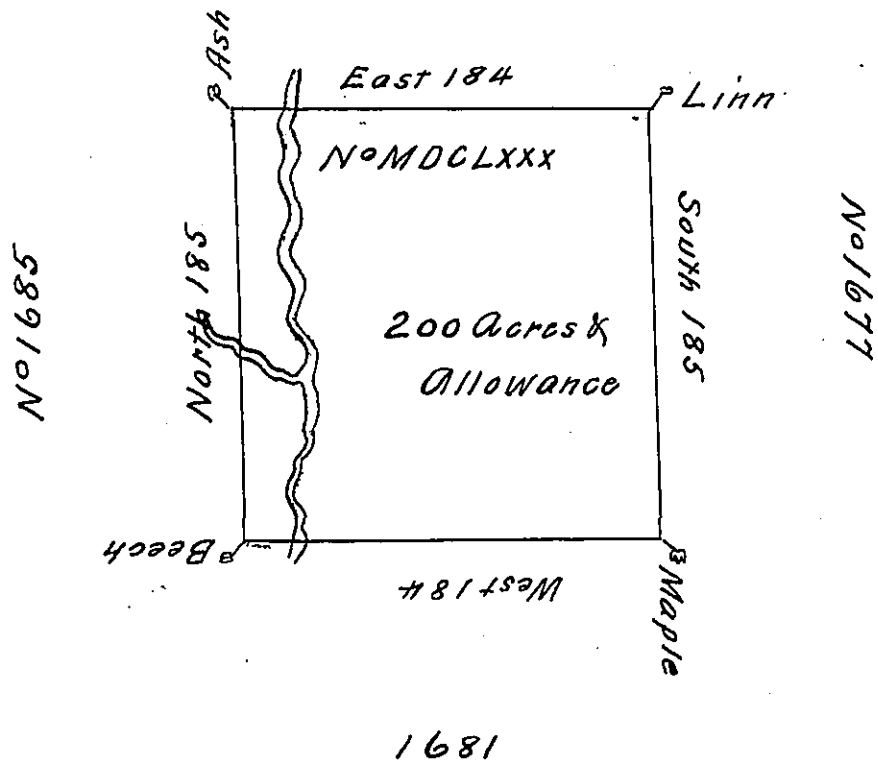

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 24 day of October 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of Six per cent, for roads, &c.
