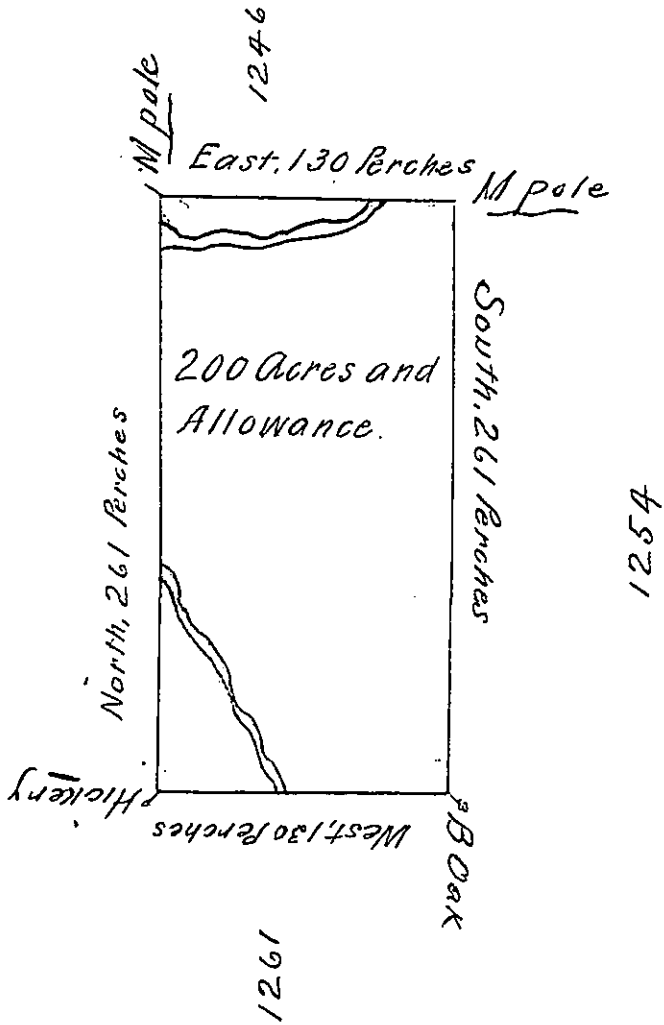


DONATION-LAND, in DISTRICT No. 6.

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the Twenty-fourth Day of February 1785 intitled, "An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth"; and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the Second Day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per cent for Roads, &c. No. 1255- Situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
