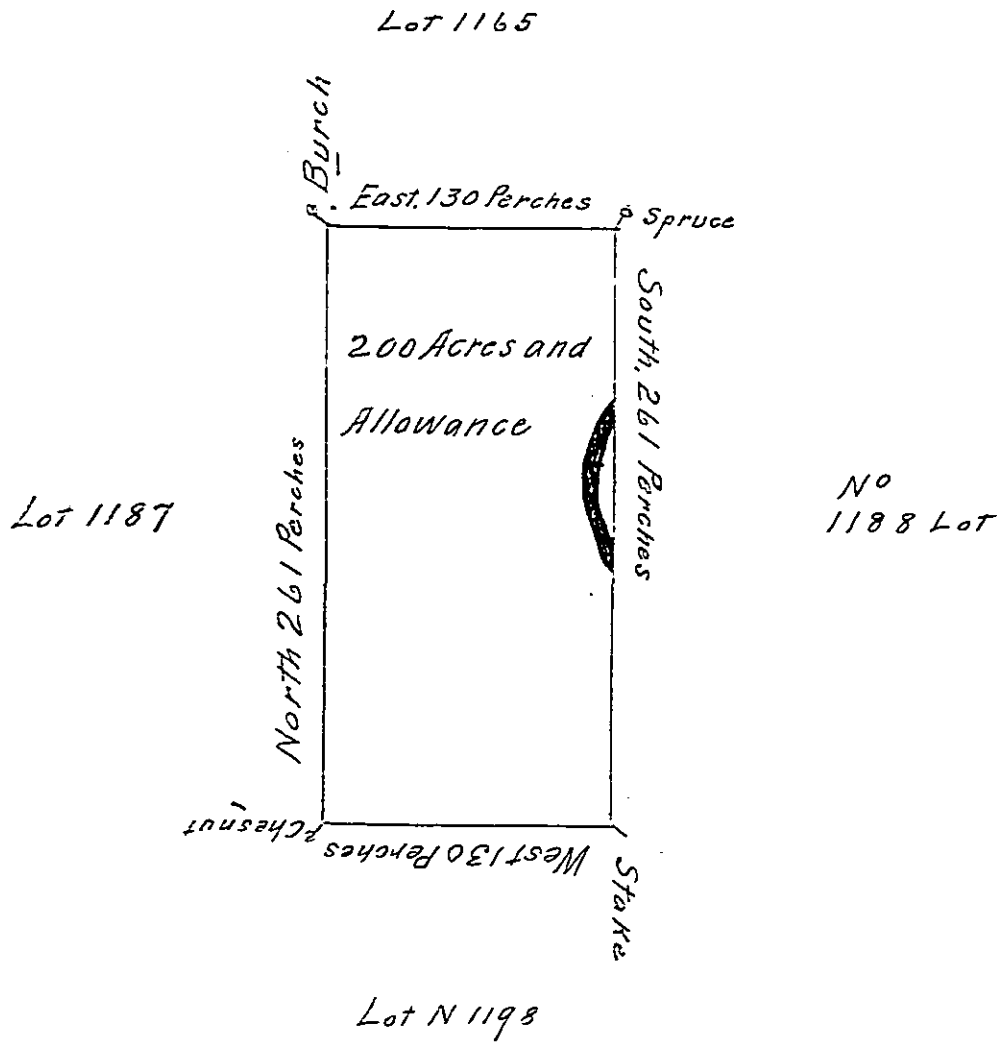

Honourable the Executive-Council, I have Surveyed, on the Nineteenth
Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two
hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for
Roads, &c, No. 1186.
