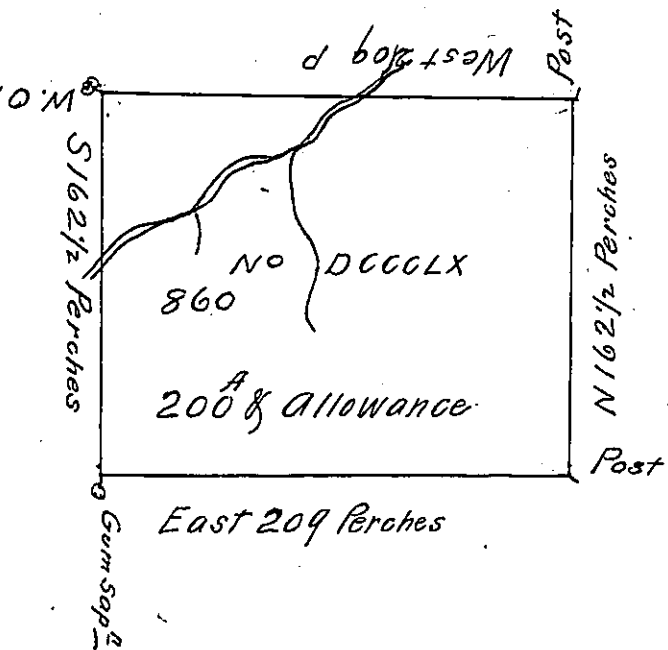

In pursuance of an Act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the State  
of Pen<sup>a</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1785- entitled "an Act for  
directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands Promised  
the Troops of this Commonwealth," and by order of the Surveyor  
General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council,  
I have Survey'd on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of September 1785 the above  
described Tract of Land of two hundred Acres & Allowance of  
Six p<sup>ct</sup> for roads &c., No DCCCLX, Situate in District No 4 on  
the West Side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland  
To John Lukens Esquire } A Henderson D.S.  
Surveyor General }

the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
