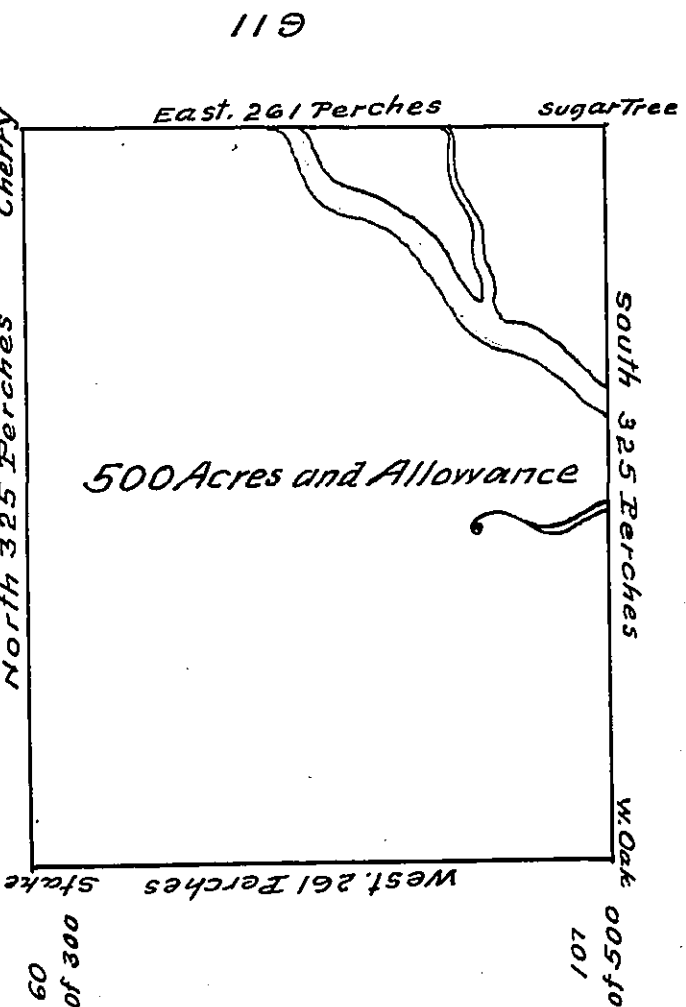

In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February 1785, intituled 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the fifth day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Five-hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. N^o 108. situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
