The Lake coulered lines represent a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Mooney on Warrant dated the 24th December 1791— this tract interferes one hundred and fifty four acres with the Conrad Weat survey. — Even Shelby obtained a Warrant from the Proprietaries of Maryland dated the 19th day of May 1763 for this land and then conveyed to Conrad Weat who entered the above Location and Conveyed to Henry Warford who conveyed to John Guthrice who conveyed to John Mooney who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and Conveyed to John Cook who conveyed to Joseph Graves the present owner.
