



Application 3804 - 2^d June 1767 to Moses McLean for 150 ac in Cumberland Township in the South Mountain.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Application 3804 granted 2^d June 1767 to Moses McLean for 150 ac in Cumberland Township on lands situate in Cumberland now Franklin Town P Adams County and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand
