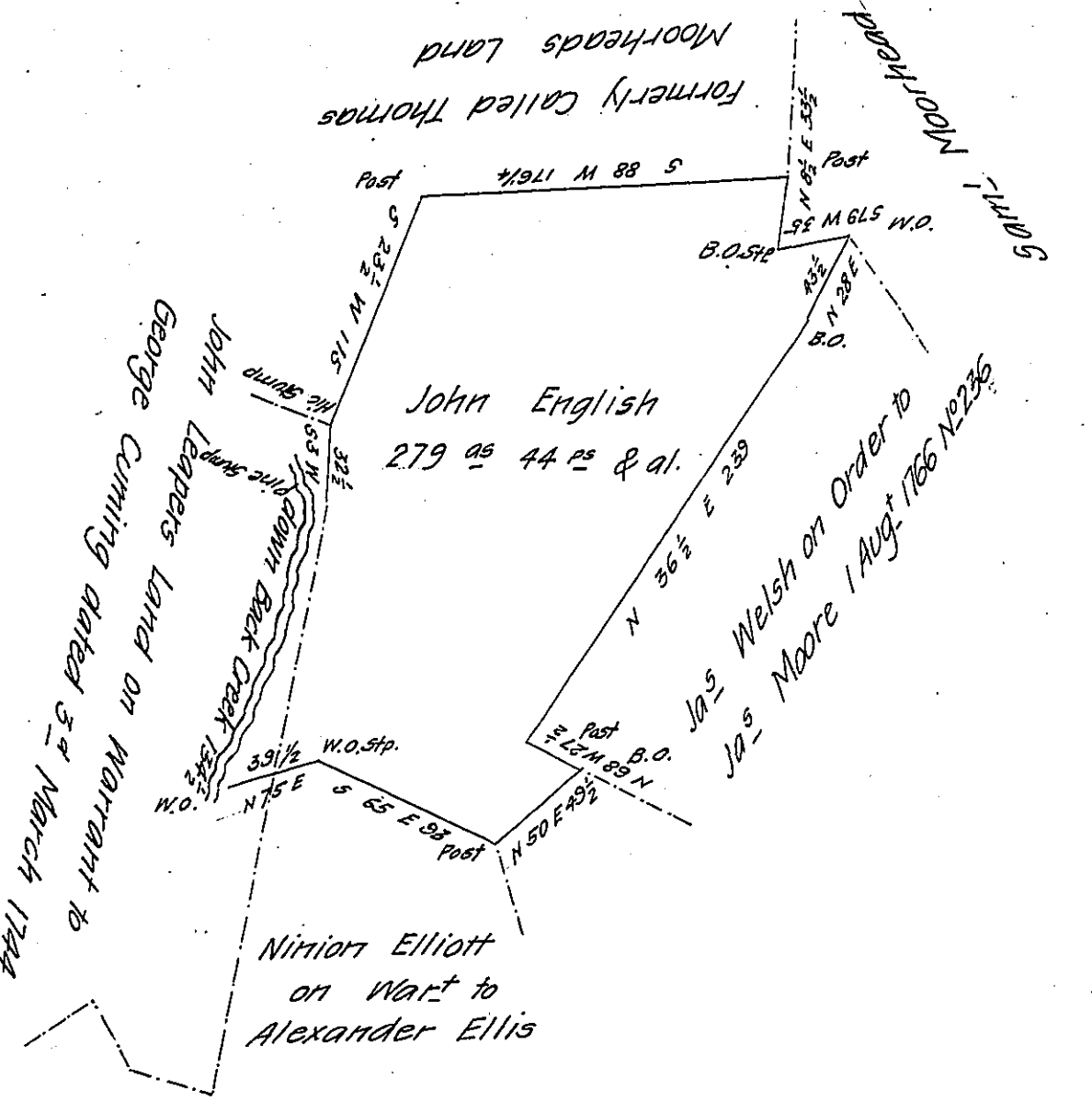

Report.—The above Tract is wholly the same as a Tract of 270 1/2 acres which was surveyed the 14 May 1768 on an Order to Catherine McCormack for 300 As dated 3<sup>d</sup> of March 1767 No 2955— which Tract is owned by the heirs of James Buchanan decd & the heirs of Samuel ~~Byrd~~ <sup>Purviance</sup> decd under the title founded on the Order to said Catherine McCormack John Shalletor Occupant W. S. Davis.
