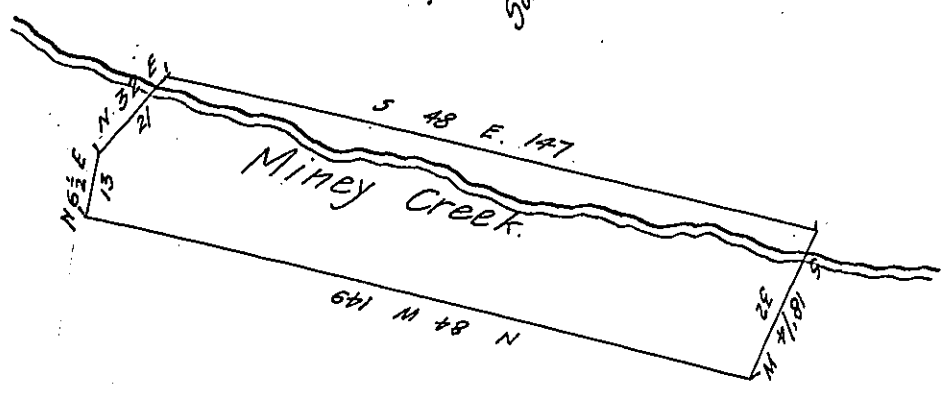


Joseph and Samuel Scott



Application 3734 - 26<sup>th</sup> May 1767 to Phineas Dorson jun<sup>r</sup> for 30 ac. on the waters of Miney Creek.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed App<sup>l</sup> 3734 granted 26<sup>th</sup> May 1767 to Phineas Dorson jun<sup>r</sup> for 30<sup>ac</sup> on the waters of Miney Creek on Lands situate as aforesaid in Liberty Township Adams County and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram
